# Enhancement & Expansion of Programs

TWC's Prevention Coalition Partners completed a Violence Prevention Strategic Plan with plans to launch in 2021.

TWC and YKHC are partnering to expand SART services to the five subregional clinics in the YK Delta so people have easier access to holistic services after a sexual assault.

TWC's contracted clinician and shelter staff began a Strengthening Families Parent Discussion Group for residents in the shelter to great success.

TWC's Children's Advocates have begun doing developmental screenings (Ages and Stages-Social Emotional--ASQ-SE) for children in the shelter in order to better connect them to services.
