- **We serve the villages throughout the Yukon and Kuskokwim Delta including Bethel.**
- **We provide services to children and families who have been referred to us by our investigative partners; Alaska State Troopers, Bethel Police**

Department and the Office of Children's services. The referrals are those with allegations of child abuse and majority of allegations are child sexual abuse.

- **We provide forensic interview services to children up to age 18 and can young adults over the age of 18 depending on their needs or other.**
- **We work with children and their families with follow-up services; home phone-calls, home visits, helping with getting families connected to other**

resources that provide other families needs.

- **We also travel on requests to villages to deliver education on issues regarding child sexual abuse; prevention, reporting, healing, etc.**
